Health and Travel Insurance

Most students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zealand unless they are:

- A resident or citizen of Australia; or
- A national of the United Kingdom in New Zealand; or
- The holder of a temporary permit that is valid for two years or more.

If you do not belong to one of these special categories and you receive medical treatment during your visit, you will be liable for the full costs of that treatment. Mount Hutt College Methven requires all international students to have insurance that will cover the cost of medical treatment in New Zealand for the duration of their stay in New Zealand. We also strongly recommend that you obtain insurance to cover your travel to and from New Zealand.
