

## Mount Hutt College Uniform



In 2009 a new uniform was introduced. In 2011 this is compulsory for all students in Years 7, 8, and 9. New enrolments for 2011 are expected to wear the new uniform, except if entering years 10-13 classes. All students will be in the new uniform in 2012.

### NEW UNIFORM DETAILS

#### Girls

<p><b>Summer</b> (Worn in Terms 1 &amp; 4)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation skirt to be worn just above the knee.</li> <li>▪ Short sleeved shirt with MHC logo. Able to be worn out over skirt.</li> <li>▪ Jersey – regulation black with red/white trim.</li> </ul> <p>And/or Vest - regulation black with red/white trim.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ White or black ankle socks.</li> <li>▪ Shoes – black leather t-bar, lace up or sandals.</li> <li>▪ Cap (plain black or white only) – or school cap available from the College office. Not worn inside. (Optional item).</li> </ul>
<p><b>Winter</b> (Worn in Terms 2 &amp; 3)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation kilt to be worn mid calf length.</li> <li>▪ Long sleeved white shirt to be worn <b>tucked in</b>.</li> <li>▪ Jersey – regulation black with red/white trim.</li> </ul> <p>And/or Vest – regulation black with red/white trim.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Black knee high socks or tights.</li> <li>▪ Black leather shoes.</li> <li>▪ Blazer – black with school crest – compulsory in Years 11-13 – Optional for any other year.</li> <li>▪ School tie – compulsory in Years 9-13. (Available from College office)</li> <li>▪ Jacket – any plain black waterproof jacket (not to be worn in class). A waterproof black jacket with school crest is also available from Ashburton Apparel.</li> <li>▪ Scarf/Beanies – plain black or white. Not worn inside. (Optional item)</li> </ul>

#### Boys

<p><b>Summer</b> (Worn in Terms 1 &amp; 4)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation black shorts.</li> <li>▪ Short sleeved shirt with MHC logo. Able to be worn out over shorts.</li> <li>▪ Jersey – regulation black with red/white trim.</li> </ul> <p>And/or Vest - regulation black with red/white trim.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Socks - Black with red/white trim.</li> <li>▪ Shoes – black leather lace up or sandals.</li> <li>▪ Cap (plain black or white only) – or school cap available from the College office. Not worn inside. (Optional item).</li> </ul>
<p><b>Winter</b> (Worn in Terms 2 &amp; 3)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation black trousers (compulsory for Yr 11-13 students in winter)</li> <li>▪ Long sleeved white shirt to be worn <b>tucked in</b>.</li> <li>▪ Jersey – regulation black with red/white trim.</li> </ul> <p>And/or Vest – regulation black with red/white trim.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Socks - Black with red/white trim or black ankle socks with trousers.</li> <li>▪ Black leather shoes.</li> <li>▪ Blazer – black with school crest – compulsory from Year 11-13 – Optional for any other year.</li> <li>▪ School tie – compulsory from Year 9-13. (Available from school office).</li> <li>▪ Jacket – any plain black waterproof jacket (not to be worn in class). A waterproof black jacket with school crest is also available from Ashburton Apparel.</li> <li>▪ Scarf/Beanies – plain black or white. Not worn inside.</li> </ul>

### General – standards of presentation

<b>Personal presentation</b>	No make-up or coloured nail varnish is to be worn with school uniform. Neat and tidy hairstyles expected with hair clear of the face. Extreme hairstyles are not allowed. Any coloured hair must be natural looking. Red or black hair ties may be worn. Boys must be clean shaven.
<b>Jewellery</b>	A watch and one plain ring is permitted. Only one plain, small stud or sleeper is to be worn in each ear lobe. Additional body piercing is not allowed. No other jewellery is permitted unless proper application has been made to the Principal and consent given. Consent will be given only in exceptional circumstances and with special provisions. Teachers may confiscate any jewellery worn in breach of this rule. It will not be returned until the end of the term. The school does not accept responsibility for confiscated jewellery items.
<b>Undergarments</b>	All singlets and T-shirts worn under uniform clothing must be plain white. Long sleeved shirt/skivvies not to be worn under short sleeved ones.
<b>Uniform exemption</b>	The uniform must be worn correctly at all times. If there are any problems, the student should have a diary note from a parent which clearly explains the reason for incorrect uniform in order to be given a temporary exemption. The student should show this note to their Form Teacher at the morning Form Meeting or Assembly. When the exemption is for a single day and for an acceptable reason then the Form Teacher will sign the diary to give the exemption. The Form Teacher will refer the student to the Dean or Senior Leadership if an exemption is requested for a longer time period or if no acceptable reason is provided. The Dean or Senior Leader will issue a uniform pass for the student to carry if the exemption is approved. Students in incorrect uniform or wearing uniform incorrectly can expect a consequence. If for health reasons certain items cannot be worn, a medical certificate must be presented to the Principal annually.



## OLD UNIFORM DETAILS

**In 2011 the old uniform can be worn in Years 10-13 only, with the exception that the white polo shirts and red polar fleeces of the old uniform are no longer accepted as part of our uniform and must be replaced with new uniform items. All students are expected to be fully in the new uniform in 2012.**

<b>Summer</b> (Worn in Terms 1 & 4)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation skirt to be worn just above the knee.</li> <li>▪ Short sleeved shirt.</li> <li>▪ Jersey regulation red or new black (and/or vest)</li> <li>▪ White ankle socks.</li> <li>▪ Shoes – black or brown leather t-bar, lace up or sandel.</li> <li>▪ Cap (plain black or white only) – or school cap available from the College office. Not worn inside. (Optional item).</li> </ul>
<b>Winter</b> (Worn in Terms 2 & 3)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation kilt to be worn mid calf length.</li> <li>▪ Long sleeved white shirt to be worn <b>tucked in</b>.</li> <li>▪ Jersey – red wool or new black (and/or vest)</li> <li>▪ Brown tights or knee length socks.</li> <li>▪ Black or brown leather shoes.</li> <li>▪ Jacket – any plain black waterproof jacket (not to be worn in class). A waterproof black jacket with school crest is also available from Ashburton Apparel.</li> <li>▪ Scarf/Beanies – plain black or white. Not worn inside. (Optional item)</li> </ul>

### Boys

<b>Summer</b> (Worn in Terms 1 & 4)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation grey shorts.</li> <li>▪ Short sleeve shirt.</li> <li>▪ Jersey – red wool or new black (and/or vest)</li> <li>▪ Socks – Grey with black/white stripe.</li> <li>▪ Shoes – black or brown leather lace shoe or sandal.</li> <li>▪ Cap (plain black or white only) – or school cap available from the College office. Not worn inside. (Optional item).</li> </ul>
<b>Winter</b> (Worn in Terms 2 & 3)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Regulation grey trousers (compulsory for Yr 11-13 students in winter)</li> <li>▪ Regulation grey shorts.</li> <li>▪ Long sleeved white shirt to be worn <b>tucked in</b>.</li> <li>▪ Jersey – regulation red</li> <li>▪ Socks – grey with white/black stripes.</li> <li>▪ Black or brown leather shoes.</li> <li>▪ Jacket – any plain black waterproof jacket (not to be worn in class). A waterproof black jacket with school crest is also available from Ashburton Apparel.</li> <li>▪ Scarf/Beanies – plain black or white. Not worn inside.</li> </ul>

**Please note:** When old uniform is worn out new uniform items can be purchased and worn as follows:

- Old kilt, skirt, shorts and trousers can be worn with black new regulation jumper.
- New kilt, skirt, shorts and trousers must be worn with new shirts. Old red wool jersey can be worn (in 2011).
- New uniform socks can be worn with existing uniform.
