



2011 Annual School Goals

Learning - *Passion*

Goal 1 (Student achievement)

To raise student achievement for identified groups of students by identifying barriers to their achievement and implementing strategies to overcome these barriers.

Targets

NCEA achievement

Strategies will be employed to raise the expectations of students about gaining Merit and Excellence endorsed certificates. The percentage of students gaining these certificates will be raised to be close to the national average at all senior levels.

Year 11 Merit at least 30% (2010 42%); Excellence at least 7% (2010 7%)

Year 12 Merit raised to 20% (2010 10.9%); Excellence raised to 5% (2010 0%)

Year 13 Merit at least 15% (2010 23.5%); Excellence raised to 3% (2010 2.9%)

Boys' achievement

Encourage boys to aim for high standards

In NCEA the percentage of boys with endorsements; Merit, Excellence and individual subject.

Year 11 35% of all boys **Year 12** 25% of all boys **Year 13** 20% of all boys

Year 7 and 8 National standard results will be similar to the girls

Year 9 and 10: Monitor Boys PRIDE points to make sure they do not make up a disproportionate number of the low results

National standards achievement

Writing: Increase the percentage of students reaching the National Standard to 60% in Year 7 and 40% in Year 8.

Reading: Increase the range of genre read by Year 7 and 8 students.

Mathematics: Increasing the percentage of students achieving Level 7 in Proportions and Ratios 60% in Year 7 and 80% in Year 8. (2010 45% of Year 6 and 65% Year 7 had reached Level 7 in this area)

Maori achievement

Work with last year's Professional Learning Group (PLG) and identify Maori students and see if their success rates are similar to other students.

Goal 2 (Student achievement)

To raise student engagement through effective teaching strategies and effective behaviour management.

Targets

Fortnightly PRIDE

Monitor the fortnightly PRIDE points so they increase during the year and identify the students the students with low value (2.5). By focusing on these students and their families reduce the number of students in this range (0 to 2.5)

ICT and engagement

Survey students to see if student engagement is been enhanced by the ICT project. Survey students to develop baseline data and resurvey at the end of the year to see if students believe their engagement has been increased.

Citizenship – Respect

Goal 3

To strengthen and embed a culture of respect in all aspects of school life.

Target

Survey students and staff to establish the current understanding of respect occurring in the College. Then use PRIDE to enhance respect in identified areas.

Community - Involvement

Goal 4

To encourage greater participation by caregivers in their child's learning progress.

Targets

Absenteeism

Reduce the % of students with more than 40 half day absences.

Parental involvement at school

To increase to 100% attendance by caregivers at goal setting meetings with form teacher
